

The future of Open Scoring in Ring Sports

This is to give a short introduction to the future implementation of an open scoring system in various kickboxing disciplines.

- In todays <u>Semicontact</u> discipline we have open scoring system visible through electronic system. Also we have open scoring in the disciplines <u>Musical Forms and Aero Kick.</u>
- WAKO Board have discussed different versions of open scoring and investigated certain system. In our Junior and Cadets European Championship in Faro, Portugal November 2007 we tried a open scoring system in the Light Contact with success.
- In our Rules upgrading process which have been carried out the last 2 years, this issue is handeled separately and based on the experience from our Junior Championships. Or goals is to, within a 2 years time period, integrate a full open scoring with running points. This was decided in our Board meeting held 29 November 2007.
- To do this as correct as possible WAKO will seek guidance with the sports that practice such a system and develop together with suppliers of such system and with organizations with knowledge that can help us. An official plan for implementation will be detailed as:
 - o Point system definition in the rules
 - Control and monitoring of the system
 - o Responsibility and consequences for judges
 - o Implementation in the countries
 - o WAKO assistance
 - User system and cost-effectiviness
- An issue is to find a system possible to integrate for WAKO and their affiliated members and to find a system as cost-effective as possible.
- The open scoring system is ment to be used in rest of the kickboxing disciplines in Ring Sports (Fullcontact, Low-kick and K1-Rules) and in Lightcontact.
